Changes information about specified user. Check "data" example below.

## Parameters

Name	Type	Description
<b>loginid</b> required	string	specified user id
<b>data</b> optional	object	information about user
<b>cb</b> optional	function	callback function

## Example

this.userEdit = function(loginid, data, cb) {  
  if(data.password)  
    data.password = _cryptString(data.password);  
  return _request({  
    method: 'POST',  
    url: '/user/edit/'+loginid,  
    data: data,  
    callback: cb  
  });  
};
```
